APPROACHING GOD IN CONFESSION AND SERVICE

Call to Confession:

I Peter 4:1-5

“Since Christ suffered in His body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude, because he who has suffered in his body is done with sin. As a result, he does not live the rest of his earthly life for evil human desires, but rather for the will of God. For you have spent enough time in the past doing what pagans choose to do — living in debauchery, lust, drunkenness, orgies, carousing and detestable idolatry. They think it strange that you do not plunge with them into the same flood of dissipation, and they heap abuse on you. But they will have to give account to Him Who is ready to judge the living and the dead.”

Prayer of Confession in Unison:

Father, You tell us the time for the flesh is over. We are not to follow our evil, human desires. Our purpose is not to live as the pagans do, but to live in such a way as to please our Savior. Forgive us for often choosing to live like the pagans in the darkness of their mind. Help us to live for the will of God.
