## APPROACHING GOD IN CONFESSION AND SERVICE

**Call to Confession:**

*I John 3:9-10*

“No one born of God makes a practice of sinning, for God’s seed abides in him, and he cannot keep on sinning because he has been born of God. By this it is evident who are the children of God, and who are the children of the devil: whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is the one who does not love his brother.”

**Prayer of Confession in Unison:**

**Our Father in heaven, we know that the one born of God does not practice sin because he has a new nature within him. We have been born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God. You have become our Father. We have been born into Your eternal family.**

**We know that our old nature leads us into sin, but the new nature leads us into a holy life. Father, nourish us with Your Word that we may have power to resist the downward pull of the world, the flesh and the devil, and to live before You.**
